## COURSE OVERVIEW

### CEP I, SEMESTER 1--

ENGLISH COMPOSITION I IS THE FIRST IN A TWO-COURSE COMPOSITION SEQUENCE. THE CENTRAL PURPOSES OF ENGLISH COMPOSITION I ARE TO DEVELOP CRITICAL READING AND THINKING SKILLS AND TO WRITE THESIS-DRIVEN, TEXT-BASED ESSAYS.

THE COURSE TAKES A PROCESS-ORIENTED APPROACH TO WRITING THAT INCORPORATES PREWRITING, DRAFTING, REVIEWING, AND REVISING. STUDENTS IN ENGLISH COMPOSITION I LEARN BASIC RESEARCH SKILLS AND APPLY THEM TO AT LEAST ONE TEXT-BASED RESEARCH ESSAY.

### CEP II, SEMESTER 2--

ENGLISH COMPOSITION II IS THE SECOND IN A TWO-COURSE COMPOSITION SEQUENCE THAT CONTINUES TO EXPAND AND REFINE ANALYTICAL WRITING AND CRITICAL READING SKILLS.

STUDENTS PRODUCE A SERIES OF DOCUMENTED ESSAYS BASED ON A RANGE OF FICTION AND NON-FICTION SOURCES, FOCUSING ON THE CHALLENGES POSED BY WRITING LONGER ESSAYS AND USING ADVANCED RESEARCH TECHNIQUES.

## COST

FOR EACH SEMESTER, THE COURSE COSTS \$200.

## COURSE BREAKDOWN

SINCE YOU ARE ENROLLED IN A COLLEGE WRITING CLASS, IT IS TREATED AS A COLLEGE WRITING CLASS.

*WE DO NOT READ ANY BOOKS, NOVELS, OR PLAYS.*

INSTEAD, WE READ ESSAYS, SHORT STORIES, AND EXCERPTS IN OUR COLLEGE TEXTBOOK. (*THEY SAY/ I SAY* FOR SEMESTER 1, *FIELDS OF READING* FOR SEMESTER 2)

**AFTER WE HAVE READ AND ANNOTATED THE TEXTS, WE WILL GENERALLY HAVE A SOCRATIC SEMINAR OR RESPOND TO THE TEXTS WITH EITHER AN IN-CLASS ESSAY OR OUT-OF-CLASS ESSAY.**

WE USE THE RVCC GRADING RUBRIC FOR THE MARKING PERIOD.

**OUT-OF-CLASS ESSAYS (OCE): 70%**

**IN-CLASS-ESSAYS (ICE): 15%**

**EVERYTHING ELSE (PARTICIPATION, QUIZZES, ETC.): 15%**
